Brixton Mural Walk – Come Explore!



On **15 July 2012** the <u>London Mural Preservation Society</u> (LMPS) has organized another instalment of the popular <u>Brixton Mural Walk</u>. Led by LMPS founder Ruth Miller, this walk will cover historic murals around the Brixton/Stockwell area and give visitors a chance to examine and discuss the motivations of the artists behind



these murals. Ruth will also go into details about who commissioned the murals, how the local community has responded to these works, their transformation over the years, and restoration efforts.

The Brixton Mural walk will start off at 11am at the Stockwell tube station and move to the Stockwell Memorial Mural followed by the Stockwell Pen and Children at Play. Other murals along the walk include Nuclear Dawn, the Brixton Station Murals and Big Splash among others. And more excitingly this walk will include the newly restored Brixton Windmill Mural that is one of the most recent projects of LMPS. In other words you get to see what LMPS does best – get the local community involved in making art that truly represents and includes them.

The walk starts at 11 am at Stockwell tube station and will take roughly three hours with a pub stop for refreshments along the way. This promises to be an exciting covering a range of Brixton neighbourhoods; from quiet tree lined avenues to bustling market stalls.

Founded in 2010, LMPS works to protect, preserve and celebrate murals in the communities where they were created. By building a database, organizing talks and tours, and researching conservation techniques, LMPS is in the process of putting together a comprehensive undertaking on London's murals. As an organization that has grown rapidly, we have been involved in a number of exciting projects including the Brixton Windmill Mural Restoration project that was completed on 5 June 2012. Funded by the Heritage Lottery Fund, this project was a collaboration between LMPS, Clapham Film Unit, New Leaf and Positive Arts. Bringing together organizations committed to developing community art projects, this is
